TVN S.A. PREPARES EDUCATIONAL CHANNEL FOR PHYSICIAN

Warsaw – August 30, 2005, TVN S.A. (“TVN”) announces that on August 30, 2005 the National Broadcasting Council decided to grant a concession to the Company to broadcast a new channel, TVN MED – an educational channel.

This free of charge channel will be targeted only at physicians and dentists. TVN MED is being created in cooperation with the Polish Chamber of Physicians and Dentists and the educational programs to be broadcast will be under the surveillance of experts from that chamber. The materials to be broadcast will assist medical practitioners in fulfilling their obligatory in-service training requirements as imposed on them by the Medical Profession Act.

According to the decree defining the Act, physicians are obliged to collect training points. As can be perceived from a bill forwarded by medical self-government for the Act of rules of financing obligatory in-service training for physicians, a substantial obstacle in collecting education points is the inconvenience and significant cost related to attending in person training events.

TVN Group is a leading television broadcaster in Poland. TVN Group owns and operates seven television channels: TVN, TVN 7, TVN 24, TVN Meteo, TVN Turbo, ITVN and TVN Style.

TVN, our principal free-to-air channel, is recognized in the Polish market as a leading television broadcaster of high quality entertainment and comprehensive independent news and current affairs programs. TVN 7 is an entertainment channel that complements TVN's programs by broadcasting feature films, television series and game shows. TVN 24 channel is the only 24-hour news and current affairs television channel in Poland. TVN Meteo and TVN Turbo are Poland's first dedicated weather and automotive channels, respectively. TVN Style is a thematic channel focused on health and beauty. ITVN is a television channel that targets viewers of Polish origin living abroad.

TVN S.A.'s shares have been traded on the Warsaw Stock Exchange since December 7, 2004 and are included in the Warsaw Stock Exchange indices, including the WIG 20, TechWig and Wig Media.
